### ***Afrikaans as a Germanic Language***

Prof. **Johanita Kirsten** is a full-time researcher and the sub-programme leader for Linguistics in the Research Focus Area *Understanding and Processing Language in Complex Settings* at the North-West University. She is also the editor-in-chief of the journal *Southern African Linguistics and Applied Language Studies*. Currently she is interested in two areas of research. Her book *Written Afrikaans since Standardization: A Century of Change* (2019) and several other publications describe recent and ongoing change in Afrikaans using corpus linguistic methods, and argues for a cognitive usage-based theory of language change. Otherwise her work focuses on the sociology of language, and more specifically language ideology and how it manifests in language use and metaphors, using critical discourse analysis.
